A CRL employee recently suffered chemical burns to his hands whilst installing anodes.

The employee was wearing cut resistant gloves and not waterproof chemical resistant gloves as specified in the materials safety data sheet and Sypol CoSHH assessment.

Wear suitable waterproof chemical resistant butyl rubber or nitrile rubber gloves (or other suitable variety as specified in the CoSHH assessment) when handling and installing galvanic anodes such as Sika/Vector XP or CC or CPT duogard
