


Safety Alert

One of our employees was recently involved in a road traffic accident when he lost control of a trailer he was towing. Fortunately, no one was injured, and no other vehicles were involved.

The employee was fit to drive, had appropriate licence entitlements and towing experience and the road the vehicle and trailer were both in good order.

During CRL's investigation it was discovered that the towing capability of the vehicle was 2.8t and the weight of the trailer unit was at least 3.1t.





CRL Action:

- Only CRL drivers who have been appointed, have passed a CRL approved towing course and who are carrying out a task approved by the Regional Manager are permitted to tow.
