The employee was sweeping scaffold when he removed his hard hat momentarily, turned and struck his head on a down-stand beam.

The employee continued working for a short time before making his way to the welfare area.

Before reaching the welfare area he fell unconscious. He received superb treatment by the site First Aiders and was taken to hospital in an ambulance. Later that day he was discharged from hospital and sent home to recover.

This incident reminds us that removing your hard hat, even for the briefest of moments, can result in a serious head injury.
